## OUR PLAN OF ACTION

We offer the children and youth in our program:

- **A safe place:** We build community centers — physical buildings with medical and dental clinics, libraries, computer labs, playgrounds and more — that give kids a safe place to play and learn. Beyond the bricks and mortar, these buildings are transformed by the energy and passion of the people who enter the doors, and the centers become like second homes.
- **A caring team:** Talented, selfless staff members, volunteers and supporters help our children feel valued, emotionally secure and loved. Our teams provide emotional stability during tough times, encourage children to have confidence in themselves and ensure our programs are effective and meaningful.
- **A transformative path:** Our programs in four key areas — health, education, empowerment and employment — are delivered through the first two decades of a child's life. These programs are interconnected and essential to helping children and youth break the cycle of poverty.
- **An ability to adapt:** Depending on the country, life in poverty means different hardships, challenges and solutions. So we customize our programs to fit kids' needs based on country, age and life circumstances.
